5th Annual South Dakota Salutes Event Scheduled for September 28-29

Harrisburg, SD – The 5th Annual South Dakota Salutes appreciation shooting competition is two weeks away and South Dakota “invitees” are encouraged to attend.

South Dakota Salutes is an event to raise money for the families of South Dakota “First Responders” who have died in the line of duty, as well as an appreciation event to show support for those who serve and protect the citizens of South Dakota.

Four times in an 18-month period, South Dakota Salutes responded with \$10,000 cash gifts to bridge the immediate financial concerns for families of First Responders who have died in the line of duty, while serving and protecting South Dakotans.

- Argyle, South Dakota volunteer firefighter Dwain Hudson died on April 17, 2019 and we presented a check to his family on April 24th
- Sturgis Volunteer Fire Department Assistant Fire Chief David Fischer died on September 7, 2018 and we presented a check to his family on September 11th
- Minnehaha County Deputy Sheriff Steve Maciejewski died on April 3, 2018 and we presented a check to his family on April 6th
- Fire Chief Donny Manger, of Presho, SD died on October 14, 2017 and we presented a check to his family on October 17th
